- May 29-** **Local Lenape Legends:** Ocean County Historian Tim Hart and Program Director of the Cedar Bridge Tavern, Lucas DiMartini, will give a talk and power point about the local stories of the Lenape Indians during the Revolutionary War Years and as they were transitioning to Brotherton, a reservation in West Jersey.
